

## General Education Student Learning Outcomes By General Education Courses

The matrix below identifies the General Education courses approved for credit at RSU. Each course is mapped to the General Education Student Learning Outcomes (GESLOs) which have been identified by faculty Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) to be outcomes of each course.

In order to determine how well RSU's General Education Program is being delivered, all General Education courses offered are required to be assessed when offered. Modifications to the GESLOs are to be determined collaboratively by faculty and submitted to the General Education Committee for tracking and oversight. This is necessary for a true General Education *Program*. Additionally, General Education course syllabi should report all GESLOs that are taught in that course. To this end, these courses are aligned with GESLOs and appear below.

## **GESLOs**

- 1 = Think critically and creatively.
- 2 = Acquire, analyze, and evaluate knowledge of human cultures and the physical and natural world.
- 3 = Use written, oral, and visual communication effectively.
- 4 = Develop an individual perspective on the human experience, and demonstrate an understanding of diverse perspectives and values.
- 5 = Demonstrate civic knowledge and engagement, ethical reasoning, and skills for lifelong learning.
