



Student Success (IPEDS)

- 31% RSU overall six-year graduation rate for first-time freshman baccalaureate cohort for fall 2016 cohort
 - o 32% regional peer average for comparison
- 55% RSU overall six-year success rate (graduation rate + transfer rate + still enrolled rate) for overall fall 2015 cohort
 - o 57% regional peer average for comparison
