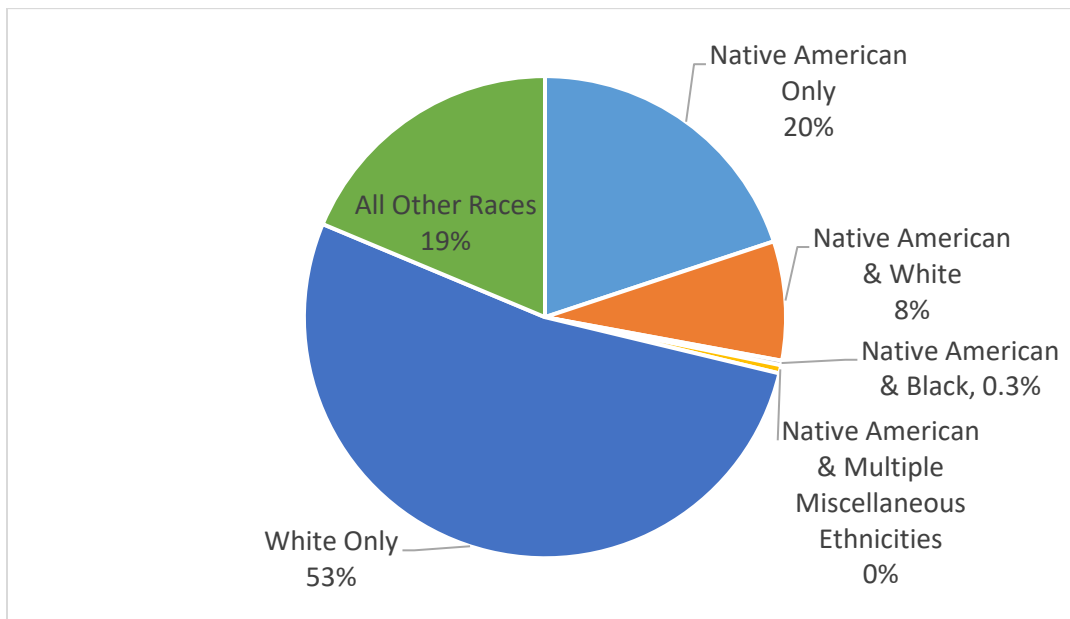


Fall 2024 Enrollment: Native American

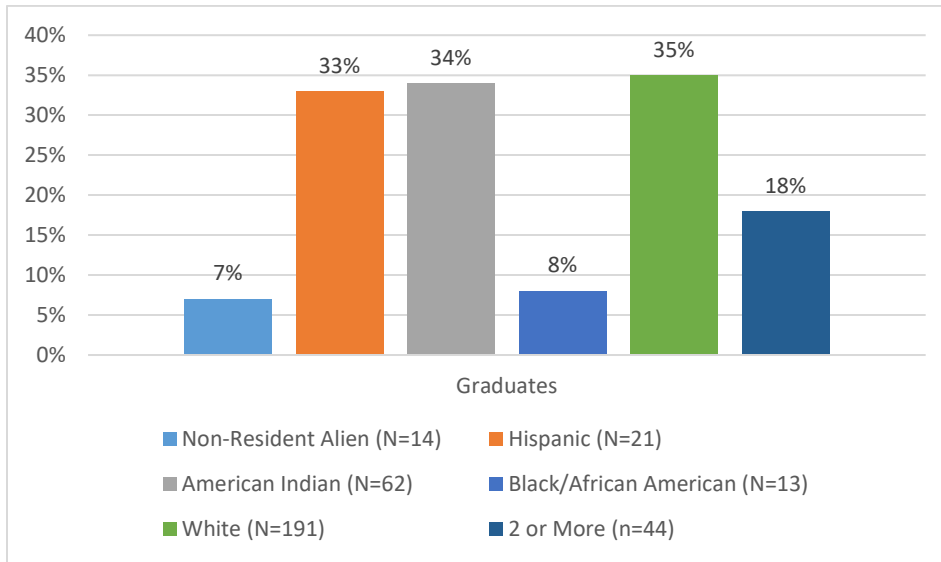

Student Success (IPEDS)

- 31% RSU overall six-year graduation rate for first-time freshman baccalaureate cohort for fall 2017 cohort
 - 37% regional peer average for comparison
- 53% RSU overall six-year success rate (graduation rate + transfer rate + still enrolled rate) for overall fall 2016 cohort
 - 60% regional peer average for comparison
